## TECHNICAL CONSEDERATIONS & TIPS

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Cases can be deployed in VR, on screen through the browser (OnScreen Web), or as a desktop application (OnScreen PC), and in asynchronous (SDL) or faculty-facilitated (ILT) formats depending on course needs and faculty availability. We recommend running a brief faculty test session prior to learner launch to confirm scenario flow, evaluation settings, and any customized dialogue or state changes. Ensure learners have access to compatible devices and stable internet connectivity before scheduled use. ACE evaluation settings can be adjusted to align with formative practice or graded assessment prior to deployment.

## NOTES
